The BOE also agreed to waive formal mid-term exams in favor of a final exam worth 10% of the overall grade in full-year courses. Final exams are waived in semester and marking period courses. Additionally, the BOE voted to offer exemptions to both seniors AND juniors who have an "A" overall average going into the final exams, as well to all students in AP courses who took the AP exam in May and have at least an "B" overall average going into the final exam.
