GO GREEN COMMITTEE 2011-2012 School Year



The Village PSA Go-Green Committee is a parent volunteer group that promotes environmental awareness through fun and educational activities. In the past the committee has:

- Been instrumental in reducing the amount of trash created during school lunches.
- Educated students by providing assemblies regarding environmental issues.
- Held an annual sale of reusable earth-friendly products to help reduce the use of plastic water bottles and other disposable lunch items.
- Requested and received recycling bins for use in every classroom in the school district.
- 5. Implemented recycling for items that are not ordinarily recycled, such as fruit juice pouches, individual snack wrappers and glue sticks to name a few. The school receives money for each item and then the items are up-cycled into new products such as handbags and pencil cases. Funds collected are used for green initiatives.
- 6. Worked to make Holmdel Schools a model for other schools on "Going Green."
- Partnered with township environmental committees to bring Green initiatives to the school
- Held Earth Week events including an Earth Day Walk and Dance, a daily green tip announcement, No Garbage Lunch Day, and an Arbor Day tree planting.
