Meeting Notes

Opening - Suzanne Niro

Suzanne Niro called the meeting to order at 9:51AM and lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Darlene Kiss passed around three volunteer sign up sheets for the **Carnival**.

Keri Todisco and Vicki DiBlasi accepted the March PSA meeting minutes.

<u>Treasurer's Report – Purvi Shah</u>

Suzanne Niro reported that the treasurer, Purvi Shah, is in Hawaii. However, Suzanne had one copy of her report which she passed around. (See Appendix A)

Linda Fernand and Sally Ann Walier approved the report.

Suzanne Niro - Nominating Committee for 2012/13 Executive Board

Suzanne reported that the nominating committee met at 9:00AM but the slate was not successfully filled.

The three vacant positions are President and two Vice Presidents of fundraising.

Suzanne then shared that the executive board needs to be filled by June and the appointed board needs to be filled by October.

For the next 10-15 minutes six PSA members (Suzanne Niro, Debbie Brew, Ana Vander Woude, Dina D'Ambrosi, Lynn Saporito, Vincent Daniele) discussed why the nominating committee did not successfully fill the slate and brainstormed ideas to fill it. During this time it became clear that the reason the slate was not filled was that were more candidates than positions. Given this, and the fact that they had only 30 minutes to meet, the nominating committee did not feel comfortable deciding the slate.

At the conclusion of this discussion, Suzanne Niro committed to share the status and any relevant decisions with an "e-blast".

Suzanne Niro - Skate Night

Suzanne Niro reported on Skate Night which was held on 3/23/2012. It was a huge success with over 200 skaters attending. Barbara Duncan, our Superintendent, even attended.

<u>Principal's Report – Mr. Schillaci</u>

Mr. Schillaci began by welcoming everyone back from spring break. His first announcement was that report cards for the third marking period will be going out Friday 4/20/2012.

His second announcement was that the parent input forms for next year's placement will be going out in an e-blast shortly.

Third, he announced that because of the vacation day we picked up from the unused snow days, Field Day will now be 5/23/2012. This is also a half day. The rain date is 6/1/2012.

Finally, he made two staff announcements. First, Nicole Newell (OT) has just returned from maternity leave. Second, the teacher of the year for 2011/12 is AnnMarie Barry (2nd grade special education).

Vice Principal's Report - Dr. Ledford

Dr. Ledford opened by reiterating the dates for NJ ASK testing (3rd grade). They are 5/7/2012-5/10/2012. She also asked that parents assure that students taking the test get a good night's sleep as well as a good breakfast. She said a parent's letter and booklet will go out Friday 4/20/2012.

Second, she noted that Earth week will be celebrated next week (4/23/2012-4/27/2012).

Third she announced the 1st grade musical on 5/3/2012 and 5/4/2012. The 5/3/2012 performances are for the students and the 5/4/2012 performances are for the parents. She asked that parents please come to the performance designated for your child's class.

Finally, Ana Vander Woude asked Dr. Ledford to remind the parents that no pets are permitted on the grounds for field day or pickup.

Teacher's Representative - Mrs. Barbara

Mrs. Barbara opened by saying that she and Ms Devaney are working to rally the teachers for carnival. Some have already volunteered to help. In addition, she and Ms Devaney also plan to ask the big buddies (from the Prime Time Big Buddies Program) to volunteer their time (and receive community service credits) for the carnival.

Finally, she shared that she is very pleased that Ms Barry received the teacher of the year award. She credits Ms Barry (and Mrs. Rosen) with discovering the bucket filling philosophy and promoting it at Village.

<u>Vice President Membership/Communications – Lynn Saporito</u>

Lynn began with an update on membership. She shared that we have been disappointed with our membership numbers as compared to other schools etc... Consequently, they implemented a program called the "presidential plea". This was a solicitation letter directed exclusively at parents who had not joined the PSA. This program netted approximately 125 new members. Our total is now 423 (64%).

Second, she reported that our *Facebook* page has 105 likes.

Third, she reminded us to visit the **holmdelparents.org** website.

Suzanne Niro added that our membership drive next year will be via a similar letter in late September or early October. In other words, the PSA will distribute an envelope through Kid Mail as well as placing it on the website to be accessed by parents. Several other PSA members offered other suggestions to improve membership. One suggested a promotion or contest similar to box tops. Others suggested engaging the

teachers to improve the membership of the parents in their respective classes.

Vice President Fundraising - Michelle Prager

First, Michelle shared that there will be no **T&T Tennis** on Monday 4/23/2012 because of the book fair.

Second, she reported that **Village Chess** is going extremely well and she is looking to add more classes next year.

Third, she reported that the school store will be held on Friday 4/27/2012.

Fourth, she talked briefly about *SchoolKidz* supply boxes for the 2012/2013 school year. For those not familiar with this program, it is a way to purchase (online) all the supplies your 1st-3rd grader will be required to bring in that year. These supplies are delivered to your child's classroom in September, thereby saving you a shopping trip. Orders will be taken in early May. Additionally, this year, several optional items will be added such as backpacks, and water bottles.

<u>Vice President Fundraising – Michelle Sottile</u>

First, Michelle announced that the PSA will be holding a **Chuck E Cheese Night** on Friday 4/27/2012 from 4:00-8:00PM. The Village PSA will receive 15% of all proceeds (food, tokens, etc...).

HFEE – Michelle Sottile

Michelle announced that HFEE has a program with TD Bank. It is called the affinity program. Basically, if we give TD Bank a list of 50 account holders, they will give the HFEE a donation. So if anyone has a TD account, please let someone from the HFEE know.

<u>Appointed Boards/ Darlene Kiss and Appointed Board Members</u>

ARISE – Ana Vander Woude

Ana shared that at the 3/20/2012 meeting they had a special presentation by Mike Marotta (consultant) about assistive technology. This presentation is available on the district website.

BOE – Ana Vander Woude

Ana reported the highlights of the most recent BOE meeting held on 3/28/2012. First, during the period from 3/14/2012-3/28/2012, there were three reports of Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB). They are as follows.
