Meeting Notes

Opening

Dina D'Ambrosi opened the meeting at 9:45AM. She directed everyone's attention to the emergency exits and then began the Pledge of Allegiance.

Election Announcement - Dina D'Ambrosi

Dina announced that April is election month. Therefore, there are ballots on each table. Please vote by completing the ballot and placing it in the striped box at the back of the room. Results will be announced this week.

<u>Approval of March meeting minutes – Dina D'Ambrosi</u>

Keri Todisco motioned, and Vin Daniele seconded, approval of the March meeting minutes.

Principal's Report - Brian Schillaci

Mr. Schillaci made the following announcements.

- Report Cards Report cards will be issued on April 30th.
- **Parent Input Form** The parent input form (optional used for next years placement) will be distributed within the next week or two. These forms will be expected back in early to mid May.
- 2012/2013 Teacher of the Year Mrs. Ferone (3nd grade teacher)

Mr. Schillaci then provided a safety and security update. First, Village school has started unannounced drills. The last lock down drill went well. Second, he has had lots of discussion with the safety and security team and staff with respect to the five parent limit on class parties. Parents have provided him input as well. It should be noted that the limit of 5 parents for class parties remains. However, there will be numerous opportunities to visit or volunteer without any limits. Examples include student musicals and the book fair.

Ana Vander Woude then asked Mr. Schillaci to assure that the selection of five parents for each class party is fair. She wryly commented that if sign up for these parties is at back to school night, the five parents shouldn't be those that can run to the classroom the fastest.

<u> Assistant Principal – Jessica Vierschilling</u>

Mrs. Vierschilling opened by making the following announcements:

- NJ PASS Testing NJ PASS (Proficiency Assessment of State Standards) testing for second graders will
 occur on 4/10, 4/11 and 4/12. Testing will be for 2 hours each morning. Makeups will be the following

- NJ ASK Testing NJ ASK (Assessment of Skills and Knowledge) testing for third graders will be from May 13-16.
- **Book Fair** will be this week
- Earth Week Earth Week will be from April 22-26. There are lots of events planned. Vanessa Merhi is

looking for parent volunteers.

- 1st Grade Show May 3
- 3rd Grade Show April 19

Finally, she shared an update on the bus initiative. (She also discussed this in the February and March PSA meetings.) She opened by saying this initiative has been a "labor of love" for all those involved so far. The focus of the initiative is to keep students seated to improve the atmosphere and promote good behavior.

The initiative was formally launched on April 3 with four separate student assemblies. She was happy to report that so far it is going well. Additionally, she thanked everyone that has been involved.
