

Minutes of October 14, 2014 Meeting of  
Village Elementary School Parent School Association-PSA

PSA President Vicky Flynn calls the meeting to order.

Vicky thanked all bus safety volunteers with the mandatory drill this morning immediately prior to the meeting.

Principal's Report from Mr. Schillachi

Mr. Schillachi reminded parents about upcoming parent-teacher conferences, which will take place on the following half days, November 21, November 24, and November 25. There will also be evening conferences available on November 18 and November 24. Teachers will send pre-conference reminders to the parents.

Village also has a half-day of school on November 26, the day before Thanksgiving.

All Holmdel Schools will be closed on November 6-7 for New Jersey Teachers' Convention.

The Halloween Parade will take place outside on the soccer fields. There will be two parades – one in the morning and one in the afternoon. If it rains that day, however, the parade will be cancelled.

Parents intending to pick-up their child(ren) immediately following the Parade must send in a note in advance. Parents will meet their child(ren) for dismissal from the New Gym.

Vice-Principal's Report from Mrs. Vierschilling

Mrs. Vierschilling thanked all PSA volunteers who assisted with the Week of Respect at school.

She reported that this morning's first bus safety/evacuation drill went smoothly. If anyone is interested in assisting with the next drill, note that it will be held on the morning of April 14, immediately before the monthly PSA meeting. Safety procedures will be reviewed, including exiting from the back of the bus. Mrs. Vierschilling thanked Katie Evans and Jen Reddy in particular for their efforts in coordinating the bus safety volunteers and handling the bus safety initiative program. Mrs. Vierschilling reminded parents to review bus safety rules at home with your children.

Due to recent maternity leaves, Mrs. Vierschilling also reported that there are three new teachers in the third grade and one new teacher in the first grade.

Teacher Representative Report

Mrs. Renfroe reported that the Teachers' Luncheon was excellent.

She also commented that the students have well enjoyed the games that have been donated to the classrooms this year.

She reported much positive feedback regarding the Box Tops contest this year and the Traveling Trophy incentive award. She also said that there is positive feedback from staff and students

The PSA has 100% membership from teachers at this early time in the year and 90% from the staff as a whole.
