Fieldtrip Learning

In May, Mr. Gelpke's and Ms. McBride's United States History 2 students participated in a guided tour of the Vietnam War Memorial and Museum & Educational Center at the PNC Center in Holmdel NJ. This tour provided an opportunity for students to learn the history of the Vietnam War, as well as have a chance to speak with Veterans who served. The juniors responded very positively to the experience, asked great questions of the veterans, and came away with a richer understanding of the era.

On May 28, 2013 Mr. Gelpke's Advanced Placement Government and Politics students visited the Constitution Center and Independence Hall in Philadelphia. At Independence Hall they took a guided tour, led by National Park rangers. This tour began in the courtroom where lawyers from opposing sides shared tables and law books. George

Washington's "rising sun" chair dominates the Assembly Room which is arranged as it was during the Constitutional Convention. At the Constitution Center, students participated in *Freedom Rising*, an inspiring, 17-minute multimedia theatrical production as well as The *Story of We the People*, a dynamic, interactive exhibition that covers relevant issues of today, including gun control and search and seizure. We also had the opportunity to visit *Signers' Hall*, where you can sign the Constitution alongside 42 lifesize, bronze statues of the Founding Fathers and engage in educational daily museum programs.
