Question and Answer Session

- 1) Question for Mr. Howard from Laura Ferreti: Is it true that class size numbers, especially in the younger grades are rising or is it a rumor? Answer: The numbers are slightly higher especially in kindergarten and first grade. The reasons are complex. One of the main issues was that the projected attendance numbers were much lower than the actual enrollments. Many families didn't enroll until the very end because of COVID-related reasons. So the projected number of sections were lower than in the past. Once the school year starts it's extremely difficult to open a new section because students would have to switch teachers, etc. This will not be a problem next year as the projected enrollment is similar to in the past and the number of sections will be back to what it was in previous years.
- 2) Question from Heidi Gabriel for Mr. Howard what is going on with the plexiglass? Answer that is a question for the District Superintendent (Mr. Seitz). No change.
