

Holmdel High School Project Graduation

Students' Frequently Asked Questions:

What is Project Graduation (PG)?

Project Graduation is an overnight celebration offered by high schools throughout the United States in which an organized, adult supervised alcohol-free and substance free post grad all-night party, is planned for the graduating high school class. Thanks to the tremendous support of our community, Project Graduation is able to offer this party, free of charge, to all of our graduating seniors.

This year, Holmdel's Project Graduation will be held at Sportika in Manalapan. Check-in for the event begins at approximately 9:45pm following graduation 6/21/22 and the event ends at approximately 4:30 am the next morning.

How do I register to attend?

Print out the Permission Slip and Waiver.

Follow instructions to complete the permission slip and waiver, sign both (Parent and Student must sign). You (student) will then drop the completed forms off at the HHS main office into the Project Graduation box. All forms MUST be filled out to attend. This is your "registration".

What is the timeline and details of the event?

6/21/22: 9:45pm-10pm Check-in at the HHS Commons When all are checked in, we board the buses and depart 11pm-4am – Project Graduation at Sportika 4:30am – arrive back at Holmdel High School

Details:

Check-in begins in the high school commons between 9:45-10:00pm following graduation. Most seniors, after graduation, go home and do a quick change and return for check-in.

The police are made aware that the students may park their cars overnight in the HHS parking lot.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE YOUR KEY/KEYFOB INSIDE YOUR CAR.

As soon as check-in is complete for all attendees, we board the buses to Sportika.

The PG committee organizes entertainment which goes on all night long! Our fundraising throughout the year enables us to provide an abundance of activities for you! This year our plans include: DJ, Photo Booth, Tarot card readers, Caricature artist, Casino game tables w/professional licensed dealers, Mechanical Bull, Grand Prix Racing, Candy Station, Giant Turf Games, a Hypnotist show, prizes and more! This is all in addition to the amenities at the event center which includes basketball courts and unlimited arcade access.

Around 3:30am- 4am the graduates are gathered to the buses and head back to Holmdel High School. We arrive back at HHS at approximately 4:30am.

Will there be food and drink at the event?

YES! You will certainly not go hungry with unlimited food all night long including pizza, subs, chips, snacks, desserts and more. Breakfast is served around 3am and includes Bagels, Danish, Muffins, Donuts and more.

Also provided: Water, Gatorade and coffee.

We provide gluten-free and nut-free options as well.

THERE IS NO NEED TO BRING ANYTHING!
ALL LIQUIDS INCLUDING WATER WILL BE DISCARDED AT CHECK-IN.

How does the PG Committee pay for this?

WITH HELP FROM DONORS! The cost of this event is approximately \$30,000. It is a wonderful gift to our students! We are 100% dependent upon fundraising activities (Sponsorships, T-shirt fundraiser, lawn signs, Chipotle) in addition to donations from families, the community and businesses.

Is the donation tax-deductible?

HHS Project Graduation is a 501(c)(3) organization under the HHS PTSO. Donations are tax deductible, subject to IRS rules and regulations.

How many of the seniors participate? Our goal is to have 100% of graduates, but typically we have about 90% participation!

Project Graduation is held to provide a safe celebration for the graduates, but it also serves a bonus purpose; It is the LAST time as a class that the students, who arrive to Project Graduation as alumni, will all be together in the same place.

Seniors, you only get one opportunity to have this last celebration with friends and classmates where you will create memories to last a lifetime. ENJOY!
